POLICY BULLETIN NO. 10-1

SUBJECT: Sales Promotion

POLICY: The Cooperative will make available certain items or services as follows:

RESPONSIBILITY: Manager and employees

PROCEDURE:

1. The Cooperative will provide current transformers, metering cable and meter for installations involving disconnect or transfer switches. The member shall install, own and maintain the disconnect or transfer switch, metering conduit, weatherhead, meter socket and standby generator circuitry, including the receptacle. The disconnect or transfer switch shall conform to Cooperative requirements.
2. The Cooperative will provide security lighting under a Rate Schedule. All security lighting under this rate schedule will be owned, operated and maintained by the electric cooperative. The member will be responsible for owning, installing and maintaining all electric wiring serving the security lighting under this rate schedule. Members will be encouraged to install sodium security lighting on new installations.

The member may purchase security lighting from the Cooperative, which the Cooperative will install and maintain provided the member reimburses the Cooperative for costs incurred. All other security lighting shall be installed, maintained and operated by the member.

3. The Cooperative will locate members' underground electric facilities at a cost to be reviewed annually. The Cooperative will not be liable for any damages due to inaccuracies in the location of these facilities. The Cooperative will bill the member for actual costs incurred for locating members' underground electric facilities outside normal office hours.
4. Dual fuel off peak heating will be promoted.
5. Water heaters will be stocked by the Cooperative in popular sizes in 80 gallon and above capacity.

This policy supersedes and cancels all similar policies prior to this date.
