POLICY BULLETIN NO. 10-8

SUBJECT: Wiring regulations and inspections

POLICY: The Cooperative requires that all members installing new or rebuilt electric services provide adequate proof of compliance with National, State, and local electrical codes.

RESPONSIBILITY: Management

PROCEDURE:

New wiring on consumers' premises shall be in accordance with the latest National, State, and local electric codes and other specifications that the Board of Directors may deem necessary.

New members constructing a one or two-family dwelling must provide an inspection certificate provided by a licensed electrical inspector noting that the inspection has been completed and is in compliance with the Uniform Dwelling Code.

Any member installing a new or rebuilt electric service that is exempt from the requirements of the Uniform Dwelling code, must submit a wiring affidavit completed by a licensed electrician or certified electrical inspector prior to receiving electric service.

The Cooperative will allow, at the Cooperative's sole discretion, emergency connections to be made without meeting the terms of this policy providing the owner makes a request in writing for such connections and provides proof of scheduled inspection within 20 days of such request.

Any cost associated with the electrical inspection will be at the expense of the member.

This policy supersedes and cancels all similar policies prior to this date.
